<b>CB013</b>	<b>TSB - Tryptone Soya Broth w/ 10% Sucrose</b>	
<b>Formula</b>		
<b>Ingredients:</b>	<b>gms/lit.</b>	
Pancreatic digest of casein	17.00	
Papaic digest of soyabean meal	3.00	
Sodium chloride	5.00	
Dipotassium phosphate	2.50	
Dextrose	2.50	
Sucrose	10.00	
Final pH (at 25°C): 7.3 ± 0.2		
<b>Directions:</b>		
Label the ready to use bottle (CB0013). Inoculate the sample and incubate at specified temperature and time. remove the top seal of the cap. Disinfect the part of the rubber stopper which is now exposed. Transfer the blood sample immediately into the culture bottle by puncturing the rubber stopper with the needle and injecting the blood. Venting: Use sterile venting needle. Keep the bottle in an upright position preferably in a biological safety cabinet, place an alcohol swab over the rubber stopper and insert the venting needle with filter through it. Insertion and withdrawal of the needle should be done in a straight line. discard the needle and mix the contents by gently inverting the bottle 2-3 times. Do Not vent the bottle for anaerobic cultures. Incubate at 35±2°C for 18-24 hours and further for seven days.		
<b>Principle:</b>		
This medium is a highly nutritious medium used for cultivation of a wide variety of organisms. The combination of pancreatic digest of casein and papaic digest of soyabean meal makes the medium nutritious by providing amino acids and long chain peptides for the growth of microorganisms. Dextrose and dibasic potassium phosphate serve as the carbohydrate source and the buffer, respectively in the medium. Sodium chloride maintains the osmotic balance of the medium.
